### DEEP SHAFT TO BE SUNK BY ISLAND MOUNTAIN MINE

It was announced recently by members of the directorate that Island Mountain Gold Mines will continue the shaft they are at present sinking to a depth of 500 feet. The objective will be to ascertain what values are at depth. At the present time the mine is working high on the hillside, and veins which are now being mined are above the tunnel level.

It has yet to be proved what lies at the lower levels in both the Island Mountain Mine and the Cariboo Gold Quartz Mine. At least two prominent engineers have expressed the opinion that the real values of that area will not appear until the veins are tapped below the level of Jack of Clubs Lake or, rather, we should say, considerably below that level. Their opinion is that the hillsides upon which the two mines are working are broken and faulted and that the real veins lie beneath this broken area.

Island Mountain is in a strong financial condition, and production to the present time for the current year is about \$277,000. At the end of the month the company will have close to \$250,000 in current assets.
