## THE HOUSEWIFE

Too much has been written about "moonlight and roses" and not enough about "strawberries and nursery rhyme who proposed to Goldilocks and promised to feed her on "strawberries, sugar and cream" was on the high road to success. He who has not thrilled at sight of the first luscious red strawberry of the season beckoning from underneath shiny green leaves has missed one of the joys of living!

Housewives welcome the season and bring out their choicest strawberry recipes. To such collections we would add Strawberry Cream Pie, Strawberry Ice Cream, Strawberry Sherbet and Strawberry Refrigerator Cake. These all look and taste like "company desserts," but are really easy to make. Sweetened condensed milk is the basic ingredient which adds to the richness and smoothness of these dishes and, miraculously enough, cuts down on the work of preparing them. A delicious and satisfying dessert such as any one of the following recipes, tops off a light meal beautifully and, at the same time, adds valuable milk solids to the day's quota.

**Strawberry Cream Pie**  
1-1/3 cups (1 can) Sweetened condensed milk  
1/4 cup lemon juice  
1 cup sliced strawberries  
1/2 cup whipping cream  
2 tablespoons confectioners' sugar  
Vanilla wafers or graham cracker pie crust  
Blend together sweetened milk and lemon juice. Fold in sliced strawberries. Pour into 9-inch pie plate lined with vanilla wafer or graham cracker pie crust. Cover with whipped cream sweetened with confectioners' sugar. Chill before serving.

**Vanilla Wafer Pie Crust**  
Roll enough vanilla wafers (or graham crackers) to make 3/4 cup crumbs. Cut enough vanilla wafers in halves to sand around edge of pie plate. Butter pan. Cover bottom of plate with crumbs and fill in space between wafers. Pour in filling as usual.

**Fresh Strawberry Ice Cream**  
Two-thirds cup sweetened condensed milk  
1/2 cup water  
1 cup strawberries  
1/4 cup confectioners' sugar  
1 cup whipping cream  
Blend sweetened condensed milk and water thoroughly. Add strawberries which have been crushed and sweetened with sugar. (The average strawberries require about 1/4 cup of sugar.) Chill. Whip cream to custard-like consistency, and fold into chilled mixture. Pour into the freezing pan. Freeze until ready for serving.

**Date Cookies**  
1 cup butter  
1 1/2 cups granulated sugar  
2 eggs  
2 3/4 cups flour  
1 teaspoon cinnamon  
1 teaspoon cloves  
1/4 teaspoon salt  
1/4 cup evaporated milk  
1/4 cup water  
1 teaspoon soda  
1/2 pound (1 cup) pitted dates  
1 cup walnut meats  
Cream butter and sugar together. Add well beaten eggs. Beat until light and fluffy. Sift flour once. Measure. Add cinnamon, cloves and salt and sift again. Blend evaporated milk and water. Add soda and stir until thoroughly dissolved. Add dry ingredients alternately with milk. Fold in chopped dates and chopped nut meats. Drop from teaspoon on to buttered sheet and bake 10 minutes in a moderate oven. Makes four dozen.

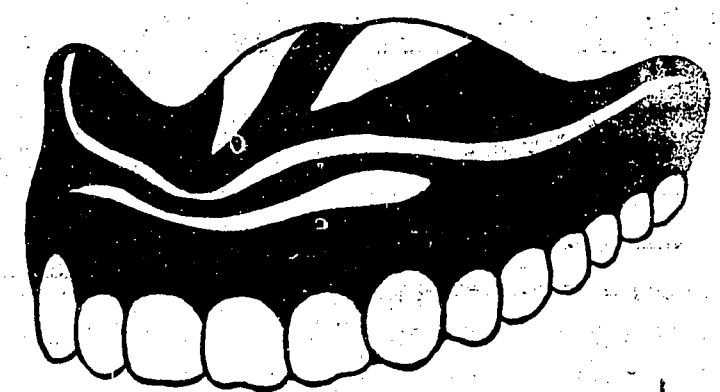
