THE HOUSEWIFE

Swiss Steak

2 to 3 pounds round steak 1 1/2 in. thick
1 tablespoon flour
1/2 teaspoon mustard
1 teaspoon salt
2 or 3 medium onions
1 large tin tomatoes
Lay steak on board, sprinkle both sides with mixture of flour, mustard and salt, pound well into both sides of steak (the edge of a heavy plate is excellent for this). Place a little chopped fat or suet in frying pan and when pan is hot sear steak well on both sides. Remove to large casserole dish or roasting pan and slice onions over the meat. Take the pulp from can of tomatoes and place on top of meat, pouring the juice around the meat. Cover and cook in medium oven for three hours, adding more water or tomato juice if necessary. When meat is cooked lift carefully to a hot platter. Slightly thicken the gravy left in the dish with 2 tablespoons of flour mixed to a smooth paste with quarter cup cold water. Pour over steak and garnish around edge with cooked peas or carrots finely diced. Serve with whole new potatoes and tiny tea biscuits.
