BRITISH COLUMBIA'S Social Welfare Programme

BRITISH Columbia's social legislation is designed to promote the welfare of children, individuals and families, suffering from various social needs. Some of the most important Acts are:

SOCIAL ASSISTANCE ACT

Social allowances, general medical services, drugs and other types of assistance may be granted under the terms of this Act. The Act has been designed to make legal provision for those who cannot be granted assistance under other more specific Acts, with the result no one who is eligible should be denied necessities essential to maintain or assist in maintaining a reasonably normal and healthy existence.

MOTHERS' ALLOWANCE ACT

Under the terms of this Act, provision is made for the granting of an allowance to mothers with children under the age of sixteen years, and under certain conditions under eighteen years, who are widows or who cannot be supported by the husband for certain specific reasons.

OLD AGE PENSION ACT

This Act enables the Province to make provision for persons seventy years of age and over under the terms of the Federal Old Age Pensions Act. Persons who are not eligible under the terms of this Act may be granted comparable assistance under the "Social Assistance Act".

CHILD WELFARE

Child welfare legislation includes the Protection of Children Act, Children of Unmarried Parents Act, Adoption Act, Boys' Industrial School Act, Girls' Industrial School Act and the Juvenile Delinquency Act, and entails the protection and care of dependent or neglected children; placement of children in adoption homes; and care and treatment of delinquent children.

Big Interests Staking Swift Placer Ground

O. Brindysen, engineer for the Quebec Gold and Noranda interests, who are developing hard-rock prospects in the Wells-Barkerville area, is also making an exhaustive survey of placer ground in the Soverign Creek-Swift River area, 25 miles east of Quesnel on the Quesnel-Barkerville road.

Already several leases have been staked on Soverign Creek and on the Little Swift River, adjoining ground held by the E. A. Kent interests. Some of these leases were held by W. Gagen, who is now on the syndicate's payroll.

D. D. Fraser, M.E., of Quesnel, is in charge of the development work being carried out there. This consists at present of sinking a number of test shafts. As this system of testing is expensive, it is expected that a drill will be installed shortly if the shaft tests at present being made are encouraging.

The ground is being tested with plans of installing dragline dredges and possibly a bucket-line dredge if sufficient paying ground can be discovered.

The Kent interests have had one dragline dredge operating at the confluence of the Swift and Cottonwood rivers for three or four months, and it is understood that results of the operation have proved most successful. This company has many miles of ground staked on the Swift River proper. More dredges of the same type will be installed by the company next year it is reported.

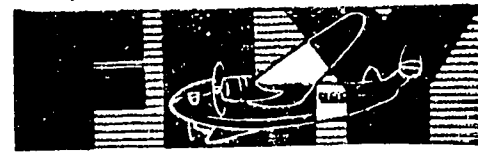

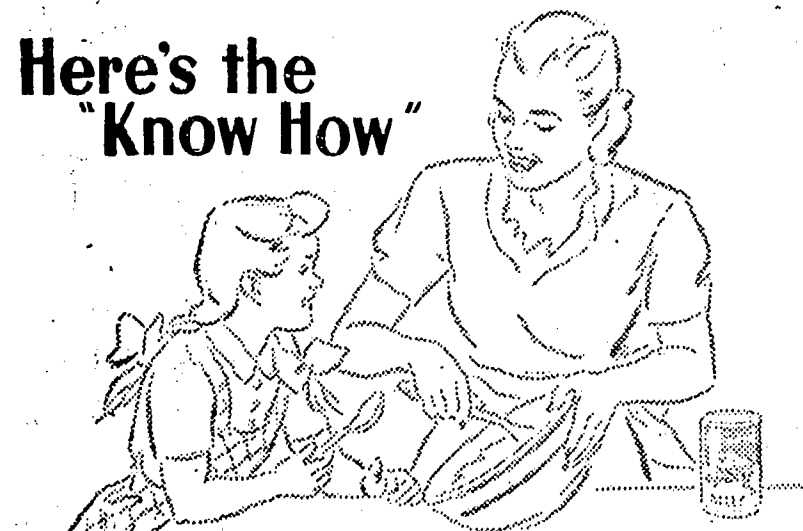
