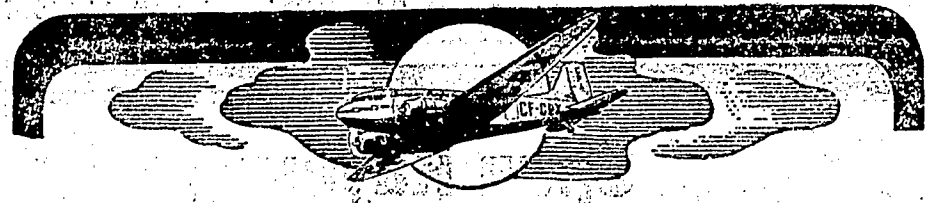

Land Inspectors Pass Through For Northern Areas

H. E. (Rollie) Whyte, Inspector of Lands, spent a day here during the week while en route to Smithers. Mr. Whyte had with him two newly appointed District Land Inspectors—Alex Smith, who will be stationed at Prince George, and Thomas Hyslop, whose headquarters will be at Smithers. Mr. Smith's territory will include Cariboo. Four other District Inspectors are to be appointed and will be stationed at various points throughout the province. An important part of their duties will be the placing of settlers on Crown lands.

Indians from the Kluskus and Nazco reserves have been arriving here for the past two weeks to attend the July 1 celebration. They are camped on the West side of the Fraser and were a week on the road—covered wagon, bennet buggy and horseback.
