### National Bacon Hog Policy to Operate Again This Season

The Dominion Department of Agriculture is again prepared, through their National Bacon Hog Policy, to assist farmers in Central B.C. to secure bacon type sows at cost. One hundred and thirty-four sows were distributed between McBride, Terrace and Quesnel last year.

These sows were of excellent bacon type, carefully checked for health and breeding. They did exceptionally well for their new owners. Many of those sows will be held over for breeding this fall. It is advisable that known heavy producers should be carried over. Young sows of good type from heavy producing dams might prove more satisfactory than sows shipped in as they are already acclimatized.

There is, however, a scarcity of good type young sows in some areas. Your District Agriculturist, Ken Jamieson, Smithers; Joe Walsh, Prince George; Jack Gray, Quesnel, or Harry Bowman, Canadian National Railways, Prince George, will be pleased to furnish information on the National Bacon Hog Policy and assemble orders for sows, for October or November delivery.

### Tractor Owners, New Residents Warned of License Regulations

Farmers and tractor operators are reminded of the new regulations regarding tractor licenses. Bonafide farmers are issued a tractor license to haul one trailer for the sole purpose of hauling products of their own farms and supplies for the same.

For those tractors previously licensed, the yearly fee is \$5. A registration fee of \$10 is also charged. These special licenses are not transferable. The minimum age for the operators of these tractors on the public highway is 15 years. The operators of the tractors must be in possession of a regular driver's license.

Another point regarding motor license is that concerning people whose cars bear other licenses than those of British Columbia. As soon as a person takes up employment he is no longer classed as a tourist and must register his automobile and take out a B.C. license. The Provincial Police emphasize that these new residents are compelled to take out a B.C. license as soon as they take employment.

### Ration Notes

Four sugar coupons are due in August—numbers S57, to S60 inclusive. Y sugar canning coupons are also valid. Farmers and other rural dwellers who employ extra help for periods of less than two weeks may apply to Local Ration Boards for transient labor rations.



**Excess Profits Tax Act  
Standard Profits Claims**

**NOTICE**

Recent amendments to the above Act provide that all standard profits claims must be filed with the Department of National Revenue before 1st September, 1947.

All applications are required to be in such form and contain such information as may be prescribed by the Minister and the Minister may reject an application that is not made in such form or that does not contain such information.

The prescribed forms (S.P.1) are available at all District Income Tax offices of the Dominion Government.

All pertinent information required on the form must be included or attached thereto in schedule form. Tentative or incomplete forms or those filed after 31st August, 1947, will not be accepted.
